

DVC Ventures “Shoot Your Bills” Contest Official Rules & Regulations



CONTEST PERIOD

This Contest begins at 2:00 pm PST on January 2nd, 2019 and closes at 10:00 pm PST on January 29th, 2019.

HOW TO ENTER THE CONTEST

To receive one (1) ballot, an eligible entrant must participate in a safety orientation to answer a “skill testing” question. Upon completion of DVC Ventures five (5) to seven (7) minute safety orientation, an eligible entrant is required to answer a “skill testing” question at the discretion of a DVC staff member.

To receive two (2) ballots, an eligible entrant must make a minimum purchase of thirty-five (\$35) CAD from DVC Ventures. Limit of two (2) ballots per customer per day.

Ballots are supplied and handled by DVC staff. Entrants must supply full name, telephone number, email address, and agrees to the rules and regulations to qualify. Secondary ballots require an additional review section to be completed by entrants.

ELIGIBILITY

In order to enter the Contest you must;

- (i) be a resident of British Columbia (B.C)
- (ii) be 19 years of age or older
- (iii) produce B.C identification
- (iv) be willing to participate on January 29th, 2019 at 6pm for “Shoot Your Bills”

Entrants are not eligible to participate in the Contest if they are;

- (a) Employees of DVC. The Sponsor shall have the right to require proof of identity and/or eligibility to participate. All decisions regarding eligibility to enter this Contest will be determined by the Sponsor in its sole discretion which reserves the right to disqualify any entry. Entries become the property of Sponsor. Entry into this Contest constitutes acceptance of these rules (the “Contest Rules”).

PRIZE

There is one (1) prize available to be won in this Contest.

The Grand Prize consists of a maximum of \$1,000 to be paid towards a bill of the winner’s choice. The odds of winning will depend of the total number of eligible entries received during the Contest period. The prize must be accepted as awarded and cannot be transferred, assigned or substituted. The prize is non-exchangeable and non-refundable.

SELECTION OF WINNER

On January 25th, 2019 three (3) names will be selected by a random draw by a DVC staff member from all eligible entrants received during the Contest period.

AWARDING of PRIZE

The Contestants will be notified by phone by a DVC staff member within 24 hours after their name has been selected. The Potential Winners will forfeit the chance to win the Grand Prize if: (1) unreachable within 48 hours (2) Did not make a declaration to the rules and regulations on the ballot (3) Unavailable on January 29th 2019 to shoot their bill for a chance to win the grand prize. If the winners are not reachable or did not make a declaration to the rules and regulations on the ballot, or are deemed unavailable, DVC will select another Potential Winner by random draw from among the remaining eligible entries and so on until a winner has been chosen. Unreachable entrants will be removed from Contest moving forward.

On January 29th 2019:

The name of the selected entrants will have the chance to shoot their bill at ten (10) yards to win up to a maximum of \$1000 to be paid towards their outstanding bill of choice. Each entrant will have one (1) magazine of ten (10) rounds to shoot at a target designed by DVC Ventures for an attempt to win the Grand Prize. The target will be hung backwards for a game of luck rather than skill. The Contestant with the most shots at the desired target will win at the sole discretion of the Sponsor. DVC staff will choose the firearm to be used.

In agreeing to the rules and regulations, the Potential Winners are required to:

- I. Confirm eligibility for the Contest and compliance with the Contest Rules;
- II. Agree to accept the Prizes as offered;
- III. Grant to Sponsor the unrestricted right, in the Sponsor's sole discretion, to publish without any further compensation the name, picture, portrait, statements, endorsements, name, voice, photograph and likeness for advertising and/or publicity of the Winner for advertising and promotional purposes.
- IV. Release the Sponsor, subsidiaries, affiliates, and their employees and suppliers from any and all liability for any loss, harm, damages, cost or expense arising out of participation in this Contest, participation in any Contest-related activity, or the acceptance, use, or misuse of the Grand Prize (including without limitation, costs, injuries, losses related to personal injuries, death, damage to, loss or destruction of property, rights of publicity or privacy, defamation, or portrayal in a false light, or from any and all claims of third parties arising there from);

MISCELLANEOUS CONDITIONS

By participating, each Entrant agrees:

1. That they have read and understood these Contest Rules and are bound by them,
2. That they are bound by any decision of Sponsor or its agents regarding the awarding of

the prizes

3. To accept the prizes won in the form in which it is awarded, and

4. The acceptance of the prizes is subject to the terms outlined in these Contest Rules.

LIABILITY

Contest Sponsor shall not be responsible for incorrect or inaccurate transcription or registration of Contest entry information, technical malfunctions, lost, delayed, incomplete, line failures of any telecommunication network, failure of computer equipment or any other malfunction or human or technical error.

SPONSOR RIGHTS

Contest Sponsor reserves its right to cancel, terminate, or suspend this Contest, at its sole discretion, for any reason, including, but not limited to, a technical failure, unauthorized human intervention, fraud or any other occurrence or cause beyond its control that corrupts or adversely affects the administration, security, fairness or normal operation of the Contest.

USE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

By participating in the Contest, the entrant consents to the collection, use and disclosure of his/her personal information by the Sponsor for the purpose of administering the Contest, awarding the Prize and announcing the Winners as well as for promotional, advertising and publicity purposes by the Sponsor in any media relating to the Contest.

GOVERNING LAW

The Contest is subject to applicable federal, provincial and municipal laws and regulations and is void where prohibited by law. All issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of the Contest Rules or the rights and obligations as between the entrant and the Sponsor in connection with the Contest shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the province of BC including procedural provisions without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law rules or provisions that would cause the application of any other jurisdiction's laws.
